MINISTRY OF JUSTICE ACCREDITED LIST FOR COURT-DIRECTED PATERNITY TESTS

Thank you for your application, dated **15 June 2018**, to remain on the Ministry of Justice's list of bodies that may carry out parentage tests directed by the court under Section 20 of the Family Law Reform Act 1969.

Having considered of your application with the existing criteria for accreditation I am pleased to confirm that **Endeavour DNA Inc** meets the requirements for accreditation set by the Ministry of Justice.

Endeavour DNA Inc will remain on the approved list of bodies until **31 August 2019**. The list of approved bodies will continue to be published on gov.uk (<https://www.gov.uk/get-dna-test>) for court users to make an informed choice of their chosen laboratory. This date may be amended to an earlier date in the event of the Ministry of Justice reviewing its criteria for accreditation. Any decision to amend the criteria will be notified in advance to all approved list of bodies with time to comply with any amended requirements prior to removal.
